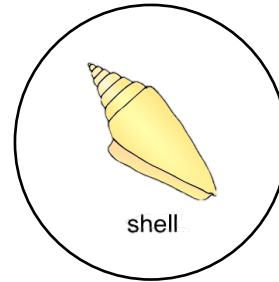
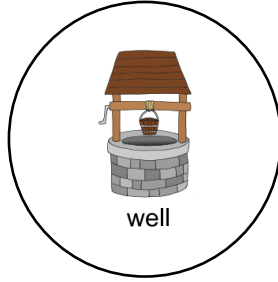


# Practicing Rhymes with Sammy's Shell

3. Parent or teacher can read the sentence out loud, pausing to allow the child to complete the rhyming word

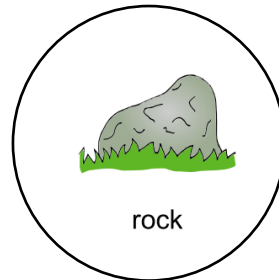
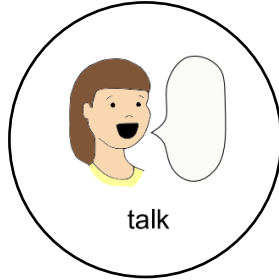
